

I. KAZAN

II. WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE



Kazan is the capital of the Republic of Tatarstan. Being the "Third Capital of Russia", it is one of the largest economic, scientific and cultural centres in the country. About 1.2 million people, from more than 100 nationalities, live in Kazan in an atmosphere of cultural, religious, and linguistic diversity. The city celebrated its 1,000th anniversary in 2005.

The 1,000-year-old Kazan can rightly be called the "young" city – it is the largest student city in Russia. About

200,000 students from almost 100 countries study here, and the largest universities in Russia are concentrated in the city. Among them are the two federal universities: Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University and Volga Region State Academy of Physical Culture, Sport and Tourism.

Kazan is the "Sports Capital of Russia". Many sporting events are held at the sports venues of Kazan: FINA World Championships 2015, 27th Summer Universiade 2013, FIFA World Cup Russia 2018, and many others.

WorldSkills Village is a modern, environmentally friendly residential area, located 20 km from the main Competition site – Kazan Expo Centre and Kazan International Airport.

The total area of the residential complex is 53 hectares, of which more than 38 hectares are occupied with buildings and 14 hectares is "green zone".

WorldSkills Village is the largest point of accommodation (more than 5,500 people) for Competition personnel and guests, as well as the closest to the Competition Venue.

WorldSkills Village is a city in the city. It has all the conditions for a comfortable stay and rest.

The WorldSkills Village has special security measures: a protected perimeter, inspection procedures when entering the territory, fire safety systems and video surveillance.

You can move around the territory of the WorldSkills Village on environmentally friendly electric transport, which runs along a dedicated route. To get from WorldSkills Village to Kazan Expo, Competition personnel and guests will be provided with transport without having to go through a second inspection.

WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE ZONES

MIC OFFERS THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:

NATIONAL DELEGATIONS ACCREDITATION CENTRE

The accreditation centre is divided into a number of functional zones: participants welcome zone, participants waiting area, data verification and processing, package management and finance, badge production and distribution, and office of the Federal Migration Service for temporary registration of participants. The centre operates around the clock from 1 August 2019 to 30 August 2019. It is located on the second floor of the MIC.

INFORMATION CENTRE

All updated information that is needed for participants is gathered at the Information Centre. Working hours: 8.00-23.00. It is located on the second floor. MIC.

VIDEO PRESENTATIONS AND CONFERENCE HALLS

These halls are designed for briefings, meetings, conferences, and are available for booking from 08:00-22:00. They are located on the second floor of the MIC.

PASS OFFICE

Pass office receives and distributes guest passes to enter the residential zone of the WorldSkills Village. Working hours: 08:00-23:00.


BANK

RESIDENTIAL ZONE

RESIDENTIAL ZONE OF THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE **COMPRISES 28 HOUSES AND** DIVIDED INTO THREE CLUSTERS.





Cluster A consists of 5 nine-storeyed or fifteen-storeyed houses.





Cluster B has 15 identical five-storeyed houses.

Cluster C is formed of 8 identical houses, consists of two five-storeyed section and seven-storeyed section.

Each residential house provides self-service free laundry, Wi-Fi and lounge and bookable meeting areas.



III. SECURITY AT THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE


CHECKPOINTS AND ACCOMMODATION RULES

TO ENSURE SAFETY FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS STAYING AT THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE, THEY WILL NEED TO PASS THROUGH SPECIAL SECURITY EQUIPMENT AT ONE OF THE CHECKPOINTS OF THE VILLAGE, AS WELL HAVE THEIR ACCREDITATION BADGE AND LUGGAGE CHECKED. THE COMPETITORS SHOULD REMEMBER THAT TOOLBOXES EXCEEDING 61,5X41 CM WILL NEED SPECIAL INSPECTION. ACCESS TO THE TERRITORY IS GRANTED TO ACCREDITED PERSONS AND THOSE WITH VALID GUEST PASSES.

DURING THEIR STAY AT THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE, PARTICIPANTS MUST ABIDE BY THE RULES OF RESIDENCE AND FIRE SAFETY.



It is forbidden to smoke, store and consume alcohol, drugs or toxic substances at the WorldSkills Village.



In addition, it is prohibited to place any form of campaign materials, as well as flags, banners containing abusive remarks and political statements. Exceptions are approved national flags.



All buildings at the WorldSkills Village are equipped with video surveillance and fire extinction systems. False fire alarms (for example, smoking in a residential building) are considered as a violation of the rules of residence and lead to the application of penalties against an offender, according to the current legislation of the Russian Federation.

Please note that it is a violation to smoke not only in the buildings, but anywhere within the WorldSkills Village.

ACCESS RULES AT THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE FOR THE GUESTS

Delegations have the right to invite guests (relatives, supporters, Delegations' members) to the residential area of the WorldSkills Village, subject to compliance with the rules of the Pass Office. Visiting the residential area is possible 09:00-22:00. By 22:00 all guests must leave premises of the WorldSkills Village, and

a representative who hosts a delegation or a staff member of the Competition Organizer must give back all issued passes to the Pass Office. If the number of passes issued does not correspond to the number of passes handed, the delegation is deprived of the right to invite the quests.

A NUMBER OF INVITED PEOPLE PER DAY HAS STRICTLY QUOTA IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SIZE OF A DELEGATION:

The total quota for visiting the WorldSkills Village cannot exceed 60 people per day.

When WorldSkills Village is visited by high-ranking guests, access to the residential area may be restricted. On 22 August and 27 August (the days of the Opening and Closing Ceremonies), guests' access to the WorldSkills Village residential area will be closed.

A representative of a delegation must provide escort to their guests at the territory of the WorldSkills Village residential area and explain the rules of conduct in the Village to the delegation. If a guest is found without an accompanying person, the pass will be canceled and the guest will have to leave the territory of the WorldSkills Village.

INVITING ACCREDITED GUESTS TO THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE RESIDENTIAL ZONE

To obtain a temporary pass for accredited guests to the WorldSkills Village residential area, there shall be submitted information to the Pass Office 12 hours before the date of a planned visit. The representative of the delegation or the responsible representative of the Directorate shall

fill out an application for a temporary permit. In this application, it is required to provide information about the guest in accordance with an approved form for accredited persons, and specify: surname, name, patronymic (if any), country, number of an accreditation badge and indicate the purpose of the visit.

INVITING NON-ACCREDITED GUESTS TO THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE RESIDENTIAL ZONE

To obtain a temporary pass for nonaccredited guests to the WorldSkills Village residential area, the information shall be submitted to the pass office 48 hours before a day of a planned visit. An application for a temporary pass shall be filled out in accordance with the approved form for non-accredited persons, indicating necessary data and attach a copy of the guest's passport.

RULES OF PROFESSIONAL PHOTO AND VIDEO SHOOT

When doing photo and video shooting in the territory of the Village, please pay attention to the fact that this is the place of residence and recreation of the Competition participants. Accordingly, the shooting process shall not distract the Competition participants staying in the territory of the Village. In this regard, the filming of representatives of other countries without their consent is prohibited.

It is prohibited to film screening equipment and inspection procedures at the WorldSkills Village checkpoints.




WHILE STAYING AT THE WORLDSKILLS VILLAGE PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:



In order to comply with sanitary standards, it is forbidden to drink tap water.



When leaving the room, please turn off all electrical appliances.



Keep windows closed when an airconditioner is on.



When leaving the room, please lock the door.



Please keep peace and quiet after 22:00.



It is forbidden to bring food products and drinks into the WorldSkills Village (except for special medical food).

V. CATERING

Meals for Competition personnel Members residing of delegations residing at the WorldSkills Village will be served at the Main Restaurant of the MIC on the first, second and third floors. Catering will be provided via «buffet» style. The dishes of European, Asian and national cuisines (including halal and vegetarian) will be presented. Information on the daily menu will be

posted on the information board at the MIC Information Centre.

Control of access to the catering zones will be performed via accreditation badges in accordance with the selected service package.

Breakfast is included in all packages and provided at 05:30-10:00.

VI. TRANSPORTATION

For participants residing at the WorldSkills Village, it is planned to organize a regular "shuttle" transportation to Kazan Expo according to a fixed schedule posted on information boards at apartment buildings.

WorldSkills Village residents will be transported by tourist-type buses with a capacity of 40-50 seats with a large luggage compartment, where participants can keep their toolboxes.

VII. CEREMONIES

OPENING CEREMONY is the official start of the WorldSkills Kazan 2019. It is an unforgettable event, which will be watched by more than 140 million people. The Opening Ceremony will take place at the Kazan Arena Stadium.

TRANSPORTATION TO THE STADIUM. Departure for the Opening Ceremony from WorldSkills Village starts at 17:20 (first flow) and ends at 18:00 (last flow). Please be aware that boarding will be carried out in alphabetical order (English) by Member country/region. Volunteers-atache will be waiting for the Delegations at the Flag Alley in the WorldSkills Village from 16:40 to 17:20 and will accompany them to the boarding point. Each atache will have detailed instructions.

Please do not take unnecessary things with you to the Stadium. You will leave for the Opening Ceremony immediately after dinner.

P.S. Please be careful, bus boarding is done alphabetically by Member Country/Region.

Member Delegates going to the Ceremony as spectators from the WorldSkills Village will board their buses on the Zone B of the Village. The departure of the first group of buses will be at 16:20.

The Opening Ceremony will end at 21:30. Buses will be waiting right after the end at the same place where you disembarked and will go to the WorldSkills Village.

CLOSING CEREMONY is an official awarding following the results of the WorldSkills Kazan 2019.

Closing Ceremony will be held on 27 August at the Kazan Arena stadium.

All Competitors and Team Leaders will start boarding their buses in the WorldSkills Village with all other Delegates. The buses will start running at 16:20 according to the system of shuttles.

DEPARTURE TO THE STADIUM

All Competitors and Team Leaders depart from the WorldSkills Village

Closing Ceremony will end at 21:30. For the delegates not participating in the Farewell Party, buses will be waiting right after the end of the Closing Ceremony.

The Farewell Party will end at 01.00. Buses will be waiting for the delegates during the event and will depart once they are full. The last bus will leave Kazan Arena and will transport delegates to the WorldSkills Village right after the end of the event.

EXCURSION AND WELCOME RECEPTION

The bus excursion will include a tour around the historical part of the city and central streets. You will see the Old Tatar Village and walk around the Kazan Kremlin. The duration of the Excursion is three hours.

On 18 August (C-5) Excursion and Welcome Reception are organized for Technical Delegates, Chief Experts, Deputies Chief Experts, Experts, Interpreters, Delegation Assistants, WorldSkills Juniors Experts, WorldSkills Juniors Deputies Chief Expert, WorldSkills Juniors Interpreters. The buses leave Kazan Expo from 13:00.

On 20 August (C-3) Excursion and Welcome Reception are organized for Competitors, Team Leaders, Official Delegates, Official Observers, Media Representatives, Future Skills Competitors, Future Skills Team Leaders, accompanying persons in the WorldSkills Juniors delegations, Future Skills Team Support and WorldSkills Juniors Interpreters. The buses leave the WorldSkills Village (P3-WV parking) from 13:00.

On 20 August (C-3) shuttle buses will run to the WorldSkills Village from Kazan Expo. The buses will leave between 12:00 and 12:30 as soon as they are full. In all other cases, Excursion participants get to WorldSkills Village by themselves. Meals will be provided to all client groups according to their packages.

Upon the end of the Excursion you will arrive at the Equestrian Complex, where the Welcome Reception will be held.


